Dr. Rizvi completed his medical degree (MBBS) at Dow Medical College, followed by residency training at Mercy Catholic Medical Center in Philadelphia. He pursued advanced fellowships in Endocrinology, Diabetes, Metabolism, and Lipid Disorders at the Medical College of Pennsylvania, Hahnemann University, and the University of Pennsylvania.

Clinical Practice and Expertise

Dr. Rizvi provides comprehensive endocrine care across a broad spectrum of metabolic and hormonal disorders, including Type 1 and Type 2 diabetes, thyroid and parathyroid diseases, pituitary disorders, obesity and weight management, lipid disorders, hypertension, and complex male and female hormonal conditions. In 1996, Dr. Rizvi became the first physician in North Dakota to initiate insulin pump therapy for the management of complicated diabetes, demonstrating early adoption of advanced therapeutic technologies.

Dr. Rizvi has extensive experience in clinical research within endocrinology, with a strong focus on diabetes mellitus, insulin therapies, lipid disorders, metabolic diseases, and broader endocrine conditions. As the founder of R Research, Dr. Rizvi established a hybrid SMO/CRO model designed to deliver precision-driven and quality-focused clinical research services. He has collaborated with global research networks across multiple therapeutic areas and has played a key role in developing clinical infrastructure to support efficient multi-site trial operations. He currently serves as a Principal Investigator at Revival Research Institute, where he leads clinical trials in endocrinology and metabolic disorders. His scholarly contributions include publications in peer-reviewed journals such as the Journal of Clinical Pharmacy & Therapeutics, and he serves on the editorial board of the International Journal of Lipid Disorders.
